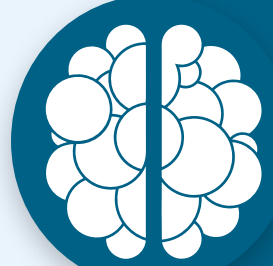




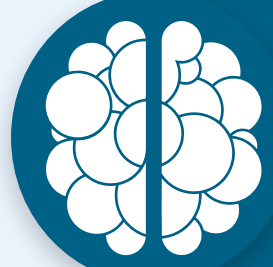
Bedside Manner & The Art of Caring

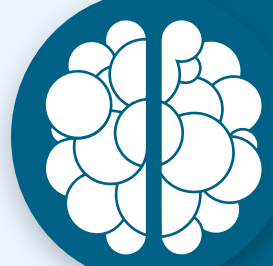
A good bedside manner requires more than just natural ability, it requires applying learned skills that put clients at ease and promotes a trusting relationship.



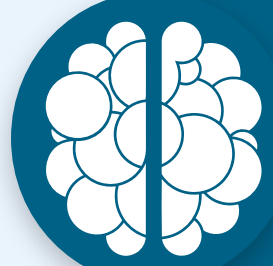
